



# Welcome to your new freesat+

Our clever box puts you in control of your TV

**Pause and rewind live TV** in case you need to answer the phone or replay a key scene


**Do two things at once** - watch one channel while recording another, or record two channels at the same time

**Build up a library of your favourite programmes** with space to record up to 60 hours of HD and 200 hours of standard definition programmes.

**Take the hassle out of recording** with no more messy tapes or timers. You can set a whole series to record at the touch of a button, and automatically record both halves of a programme split by the news.

**Store your Music and Photos** with the two USB ports, with special folders set aside for them in the Media List.

# Getting started



1. Connect the cables from the satellite dish to the back of the freesat+ box. Insert one cable into the connector marked LNB1 and the other into LNB 2 (you need both cables connected to be able to record two channels at the same time).
2. Connect your TV to the freesat+ box. Use the HDMI cable provided, or if your TV is an older model without an HDMI port, use the SCART lead (but you won't be able to enjoy true HD with a SCART lead).
3. Plug it in and you're good to go. Plug the freesat+ box in, and switch it ON with the ON/OFF button at the back of the box. Then, press the STANDBY button on the remote control or on the front of the box.

That's it. Your freesat+ box will automatically begin the First Time Installation – just follow the on screen prompts.

Your default password is 0000. For security and parental control you should change this password to a memorable 4 digit alternative.

Some programmes may contain guidance information (for example if a programme contains violence or strong language). You may be asked for your password to watch a recorded programme before the 9pm watershed if it contains guidance. Guidance information is not controlled by freesat but by the channels.

# Although different from other digital recorders, freesat+ is really easy to use and this guide shows you how...

## Recording with freesat+

### Instant record

While watching TV, you can record a programme instantly by pressing the  record button.

### Scheduled recording

When in the TV Guide, you can select a programme to record by highlighting it and pressing OK.

Where available, freesat+ will automatically give you an on-screen prompt with the option:



to record a whole series



to record the programme in HD


## Handy freesat+ features:

 **Solving a recording clash** - If you select more than two programmes to record at one time, freesat+ will search the 8 day TV Guide and suggest an alternative time to record one of them.

 **Split recording** - freesat+ automatically records both parts of split programmes, for example films split by the news.

**Autopadding** - there's nothing worse than missing the end of a programme, so freesat+ automatically adds a couple of extra minutes to the start and end of recordings so you never miss a thing.

**Autotracking** - freesat+ automatically tracks any changes in the TV schedule so that if your programmes start earlier it will still be recorded correctly.



# Managing your TV recordings, Music and Photos

## MEDIA

Press the  button on your remote control to view everything stored on your freesat+ box, including all of your TV recordings.

Your Media List is split into folders for ease of access:

-  Video
-  Radio
-  Music
-  Photos

You can easily transfer your photos and music files from a memory stick to the hard drive via the two USB ports (front and back of the box).

## SCHEDULE

Press the  button on your remote control to see the list of programmes that are set to record. Here you can add on extra time at the start and end of a programme, for example if you think a match is going to go into extra time.

## Handy pointers:

Look out for the prompts at the bottom of the screen which should point you in the right direction.

A handy tip if you ever get lost in the TV Guide or Media Library is to press  to return to full screen TV.
